














existing byes. This is the only mid-week day time competition for the men in the New Year. Women can also play in this event. Ring Mike if you wish to play. Men's double triples on Tuesday 22 evenings, women's double triples on Wednesday 23 afternoons and development pairs on Thursday 24 evenings.

The development pairs are being played under a different concept. All teams within a section will play at the same green. That means that 3 or 4 games per section will be played at the same green. Team 1 in the section will host play on the 1st night, team 2 on the second night and so on. Of the 8 Burnside teams in the pair's competition, 3 of them are listed as 'Team 1' in the draws, and therefore there will be 10 games of development pairs held at Burnside on Thursday 24 January.
