

Bowls Coaches

The next round of Bowls NZ Coaching Courses has been set for April 2019. This is a great time for your club to promote coaching as a way for members to give back to the club and to help develop the knowledge of the sport and the skills of your members. The following courses will be offered;

Foundation

Level entry coaching for business house bowlers, students, and new bowlers. The Foundation course is a one-off course and no theory work assessments after the course has finished.

Development

Designed for those who are coaching Development and Senior players. The Development course is a two-day course with Theory and Practical Assessments. The coach will need to complete 40 hours of coaching, supervised by an appointed Development coach then signed off by your Bowls NZ Coach Developer, to be accredited with a full Development qualification.

Update

The Update Course is for coaches who have already are accredited with the Development coach qualification for 2 years. This is to Update the coach on any new technology and practices that have been added to the Foundation and Development courses.
