### Answer Question Corner (ii)

Displacement of a jack at rest.

If a jack at rest within the rink of play is displaced by a player, the opposing skip (or opponent in Singles) must put the jack back to its former position. Law 38.1.3

### Question Corner (iii)

A player plays out of turn. The player's bowl does not touch anything during its course. The bowl comes to rest 2 metres from the jack. What should happen?
