## **Umpire's Corner**

#### **Question Corner (iv)**

The lead in team A delivers the jack which comes to rest in the front ditch. The lead in team B then delivers the jack which comes to rest less than the minimum distance from the mat line. What happens next?

#### **Answer**

The jack should be centred with the nearest point of the jack to the mat line 2 metres from the front ditch (on the spot). The mat should be placed by the first player where he/she wants in line with Law 6.1.1 and play first. Law 10.3

N.B. It's worth a look at Appendix B.3 page 92 which shows the correct position for a 'spotted' jack. I often see it placed exactly on the cross – which is wrong.

#### **Question Corner (v)**

You are told that the pace of the green at 10am was 10 seconds and that at 3pm it was 14 seconds. Was the green faster or slower at 3pm?
