Umpire's Corner

Question (xxx)

The lead in team 'A' delivers the jack. When it comes to rest the skip of team 'B' thinks that it is less than 23 metres from the mat line so calls for the umpire. When checking the position of the mat the umpire finds that the mat is only 1.8 metres from the rear ditch. What should happen?

Answer

The lead in team 'B' should place the mat in line with Law 6.1.1, re-deliver the jack and make sure it is centred. The lead in team 'A' should then deliver the first bowl. (Law 6.1.3)

NB – this only applies BEFORE the first BOWL is delivered. After that, a mat less than 2 metres from the rear ditch CANNOT be challenged.

NBB – the jack should always be centred by the player who delivered it – even if he/she is not the first to play.



















Question (xxxi)

Player 'A' drives at a bowl in an attempt to remove it from the head. The player's bowl strikes the target bowl – the target bowl then hits the marker on the foot. What should happen?
