Umpire's corner

Question (xxxxv)

During a fours game team 'A' is holding 5 shots – closely grouped around the jack. The skip of team 'A' wants to protect the head. The skip walks past the head in the direction of the mat line. Standing 2.5 metres from the head the skip says to the third, who is on the mat, "I want a bowl here".

Is this permissible?

If so, having instructed the third, what should the skip do next?

Answer

Yes

Take their position behind the jack as soon as the bowl has been delivered.
