Question (XLIX)

A knockout game is drawn after the scheduled number of ends have been completed.

a) From which end of the green should the extra end be played?

- b) Who delivers the jack?
- c) If the extra end is tied (e.g., two bowls touching the jack no live bowls left on the rink) what happens?

Answer

- a) From the end of the green where the previous end was completed. (Law 28.3)
- b) Skips/players toss to decide who plays first (Law 28.2)
- c) Skips/players toss before each extra end. (Law 28.5)

Question (L)

An end is declared dead. Skip 'A' wants to replay in the opposite direction but skip 'B' objects. What should happen?
