Umpire's Corner

Question (LII)

A player plays a running bowl which hits a non-toucher which was at rest in the same rink. The bowl which has been hit rebounds from the bank and displaces the jack. What should happen? What if the bowl hit WAS a toucher?

Answer

- a) An opponent (or marker) should put the jack back to its former position and remove the non-toucher from the rink. (Law 38.5.2)
- b) Nothing. (Law 17.2.3)
