## Bar Price increase

The Executive is required to complete a review of Bar prices annually to ensure pricing is keeping up with costs. Following this review, the Executive advises that the following items will have a price adjustment effective from Monday 27th September;

### Beer

- Pilsner/ Craft beer increased 50cents per handle (\$7.50) and \$1 per jug (\$15)
- Bottle Beer - increased \$1 per bottle (\$6)

### Wine

- White and Red wine increased 50cents per glass (\$7.50), and \$2 per bottle (\$32)

### Spirits

- All increased 50cents per nip (\$3)

### Non alcoholic

Split cans – increased 50cents, all cans will now be the same price (\$2.50). (Split cans button will be removed from the till.)
