

## **COVID Vaccination Pass**



From Friday 3 December 2021 the Club will be a mandatory vaccination certificate site.

This means that every person who comes on site must carry a card/certificate/pass showing that they have had 2 COVID vaccinations, and they must be willing to show this proof if asked. Most of our members have already provided this proof, but we have just a few more to check. These people will be contacted directly. Anyone who is not yet double vaccinated must let the selectors, Match committee or an Executive member know they will be unavailable for play until they can meet the criteria.

Each member must carry their Vax proof if playing at Burnside or any other bowling club.

Check before you leave home! It would be embarrassing if a team member didn't have their Vaccination Pass to show and the whole team had to default and go home.

If you would like your Vaccination Pass laminated this Friday afternoon, please put it in an envelope, place in the office mailbox before 4pm Friday, and it will be laminated and ready for pick up at 5pm upstairs in the Lounge.

# **Umpire's Corner**

# Question (LXXVIII)

A bowl which has touched the jack in its original course is lying at an angle. There is a risk that the bowl may be moved when it is marked as a toucher. What should happen?

#### Answer

It should be nominated as a toucher. (Law 15.2)

#### Question (LXXIX)

A running bowl, which did not touch anything during its course, hits the face of the bank and rebounds onto the green. Is the bowl dead or live?

# **Bowls Canterbury Vaccination Policy**

It is straight forward and means you need to be **double vaccinated** and have a certificate to prove it to enter a club that has adopted the fully vaccinated policy or play in Bowls Canterbury event and visit the office/shop. If a club has not adopted the policy members from that club can still play in our events providing they produce evidence they are fully vaccinated. Bowls Canterbury will only be using clubs that have adopted the fully vaccinated policy to host Bowls Canterbury events.

There are still several clubs that have not advised their vaccination status. Some clubs may have decided they aren't going to do so and that is fine. **An up-to-date list of clubs that have adopted the Policy is on our website**. Friday is the day vaccine certificates will be required to enter the clubs that have adopted the policy and for those entering our events. Please pass this message on to all members because it does affect all of us.

#### Summary

Please remember that everyone needs evidence to show they are **double jabbed** (**one jab does not count**) to be able to play at Fully Vaccinated clubs, in events under our umbrella, in our representative teams and in Bowls New Zealand National events.
