Next week's Gala Pairs is oversubscribed by 3 teams. We will be doing a ballot on Friday to draw out 3 Burnside teams, as we only have the two greens we are limited to 36 teams. Balloted out teams will be contacted by Allan and will be first choices should there be any late cancellations.

Saturday afternoon - 29 September

Hornburn Trophy v Bowls Hornby starts at 1-30 pm. Please be ready to play before the start time. Teams will be finalised by Friday morning and will be notified by email. Hornby will have 10 teams of fours. This means that including our 40 players, 80 players will compete for this trophy. Dress code is whites.

Festival Bowls starts at 1-30pm. Dress code is mufti. Entry fee for prizes is \$3 pp.

Please register at the Club Office window by 1-15 pm. At this stage the 3 planned games will be triples - 1 x 3 bowl and 2 x 2 bowl triples.

So far over 70 of our players have indicated that they want to play in one or other (or rather helpfully both) of these events. 40 players will be selected to play Hornby and those who miss selection (about 20 so far) will be listed with those who preferred Festival Bowls. Anyone who enters from now on will get a game in the Festival Bowls event so this means **everyone who enters to play on Saturday will get a game!** Remember we are likely to be limited to two greens so Festival Bowls entries should be in by Friday 5-00 pm.
