Umpire's Corner

Question corner (ix)

During the measuring process a bowl falls into a position in which it is nearer to the jack. The opposing skip immediately calls for the bowl to be put back to its former position. Is this the correct way to proceed?

Answer (ix)

No. The bowl should be left in its new position and the process of deciding the number of shots scored should continue. All shots agreed before the bowl fell will count. Law 26.6.3

This can result in both teams scoring on the same end. All the more reason to carry wedges with you. (Available from Bowls Canterbury) They can be used as soon as the last bowl comes to rest – unless the skip has invoked the 30 second rule. Law 23.2

Question corner (x)

You are marking a Singles game on rink 4. A bowl delivered on rink 5, travelling in its original course and on a correct bias, is going to collide with one of the bowls at rest on rink 4. What should you do?
