Selectors

SELECTING AND PLAYING IN CLUB INTERCLUB TEAMS - THIS IS HOW IT WORKS!

You the player indicate which competitions you would like to be considered for at the beginning of the season.

The selectors then select their teams from your 'indications' taken from the appropriate forms.

The selectors ENTER a number of teams in a centre competition based on YOUR indicative intention to play in that particular competition.

The teams are selected weekly and the selectors do their best to ensure all players are given an opportunity not only to play but to enjoy their game by selecting appropriately.

The teams are posted on the website as soon as the selectors are able and also posted in the match room (usually) by Thursday evening for the following mid-week events and on Tuesday for Saturday play.

The selectors appoint a Team Captain to ensure that his/her team is 'intact' for the fixture by contacting their team to (re)confirm players availability. The Team 'Captain' is posted in red. (Team Captain appointments are shared around)

The selectors also guesstimate an appropriate time for players to meet in the car park to travel to a game.

The selectors also select a DUTY TEAM who is responsible for cards mats and jacks being in position 15 minutes before start time.

Players are asked to confirm they are available for that competition by ticking the box beside their name.

Unavoidable circumstances do occur, and unavailability's are inevitable. However long held commitments and forgetting YOU told us YOU wanted to play and then pulling out after the teams are 'posted' is very annoying to selectors as they must then ring around and plead to others to fill a gap which they (the selectors) had just previously excluded them from for YOU!

If you are selected and then find you are NOT ABLE to play, then please advise the appropriate Convenor of selectors as a matter of urgency.
