Format depends on numbers.

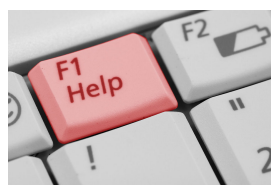
Entry fee \$3-00 pp if numbers warrant prizes.

Umpire's Corner

Question (LII)

A player plays a running bowl which hits a non-toucher which was at rest in the same rink. The bowl which has been hit rebounds from the bank and displaces the jack. What should happen?

What if the bowl hit WAS a toucher?

Answer

- a) An opponent (or marker) should put the jack back to its former position and remove the non-toucher from the rink. (Law 38.5.2)
- b) Nothing. (Law 17.2.3)

Question (LIII)

A knock-out competition is being played over the course of one day. Player 'B' has a bye in the first round. In the second round, scheduled to start at 1pm, player 'B' is due to play player 'A' who won a first-round tie (which was completed at 11am). Player 'B' arrives at the venue at noon and asks to go onto the green for a few practice ends. Is this permissible?
