Umpire's corner

Question (LIV)

Team 'A' is holding two shots. A gust of wind moves the jack with the result that team 'B' is now holding the shot. What should happen?

Answer

The jack should be put back to its former position. If the skips cannot agree on its position the end should be declared dead (Law 37.7)

Question (LV)

Team 'B' scores two shots at the 5th end to make the score 8-3 for team 'A'. Team 'A' scores one shot at the 6th end. The 7th end results in a tied end. Should the tied end be recorded on the score card and, if so, how?
