George was part of the original coaching group at Burnside, working with Len Seear, among others. He assisted Doug Youl with the Match Committee workload. When it was agreed to extend the clubrooms in 1991, George was part of the Pavilion Extension sub-group that raised over \$200,000 to complete the task.

George was in the words of older club members who knew him - 'a very nice fellow', 'a real gentleman', 'a very good coach,' and 'a great companion as part of the weekly walking group.'

George was very thorough in whatever he did, and his weekly balancing of the Pokies left nothing to worry any auditor.

George joined the club in 1976, He remained interested in Burnside Bowling Club even though he has not been around the club so much in later years. He kept up to date reading of the club's progress and successes in the weekly Hotline which he liked to discuss with all club members who visited him at his retirement villa.

George's name does not appear on any of our Honours Boards but if there was a Board for club involvement and commitment then George's name would shine brightly.
