# **Umpire's Corner**

#### Question (LXIV)

Can a player at the head place a cloth on the green to indicate to the player on the mat the position of either the jack or a bowl?

#### **Answer**

No. (Note that this does not prevent a player from holding a cloth ABOVE the jack or bowl being indicated – provided that the cloth does not make contact with the jack or bowl in case it leads to suggestions of displacement) (Law 17.1)

#### Question (LXV)

A player says to the marker "Can you show me where the jack is, please?". In response, the marker holds a hand above the position of the jack. Is the marker allowed to do this?

#### Question (LXII) - comment

Umpire Penny Pat correctly draws attention to the Bowls Canterbury Conditions of Play for Inter-club which make allowance for teams one player short. These involve player(s) playing 3 bowls instead of 2 but with a deduction from the final score. Do check the rules before next season.
