## CONDITIONS OF PLAY

### National & Development Sides

- SIDES:** MEN'S NATIONAL SIDE OF 5 PLAYERS  
WOMEN'S NATIONAL SIDE OF 5 PLAYERS
- MEN'S DEVELOPMENT SIDE OF 5 PLAYERS  
WOMEN'S DEVELOPMENT SIDE OF 5 PLAYERS  
*Age 25 and under for the duration of the event.*
- TEST SERIES:** Each side will play 3 one day tests
- EACH DAY:** Each Test to consist of four games. 2 trial ends before each game. At the commencement of each day team managers will toss to decide which side shall play first for the whole day.
- SINGLES:** 21 shots up (in excess of 21 shots shall not count)
- PAIRS:** 18 completed ends - four bowls each player, played alternately
- TRIPLES:** 18 completed ends - three bowls each player, played alternately
- FOURS:** 18 completed ends - two bowls each player, played alternately
- INDIVIDUAL TEST:** Two points for a win. One point for a draw  
No extra ends will be played  
If points are equal then each test will be decided by the highest net total of shots.  
If positions are still equal, the Controlling Body will divide the total of shots scored against each side into the total shots it has scored. The side with the highest result will be declared the winner
- TROPHIES:**
- OVERALL TRANS TASMAN TROPHY:**  
The overall Trans Tasman Trophy will be awarded to the country whose National Sides (men and women) have won 4 or more tests collectively. If tests are equal then the country with the highest test points shall be awarded the trophy. If a tie still exists, the winner from the previous year will retain the trophy.
- INDIVIDUAL TROPHIES:**  
Trophies will be awarded to the sides (men and women) in the National and Development competitions that win 2 or more tests.

## TIME LIMIT:

There will be a 3½ hour time limit on all matches

## RESTRICTION ON MOVEMENT OF PLAYERS

1. After delivering their first bowl, players will only be allowed to walk up to the head under the following circumstances.
  - Singles game
    - the opponents: after delivery of their third and fourth bowls.
  - Pairs game (each player playing four bowls)
    - the leads: after delivery of their third and fourth bowls; and
    - the skips: after delivery of their second, third and fourth bowls.
  - Triples game (each player playing three bowls)
    - the leads: after delivery of their third bowl;
    - the seconds: after delivery of their second and third bowls; and
    - the skips: after delivery of each of their bowls.
    - At the start of each end the leads and seconds will be at the mat end.
  - Fours game
    - the leads: after the second player in their team has delivered their second bowl;
    - the seconds: after delivery of their second bowl;
    - the thirds: after delivery of their second bowl; and
    - the skips: after delivery of each of their bowls.
2. In exceptional and limited circumstances, a skip can ask that a player walks up to the head earlier than described in paragraph 1. above.
3. If a player does not follow the terms of this law, law 35 will apply.

## SUBSTITUTES/REPLACEMENTS:

The Controlling Body shall allow a substitute or replacement at any stage of the competition on account of illness or other reasonable cause.

The manager of the side affected may play or call upon a player from his/her National Authority.

If there is no possibility of the replaced player returning then the new player is a replacement and can play in any position in the side.

If the singles player is unable to continue a player shall be taken from the side to play the singles and a substitute shall play in one of the team disciplines.

All games will be played under the “Laws of the Sport of Bowls – Crystal Mark Edition” with the following variation agreeable to both countries.

### **TRIAL ENDS:**

Trial ends will be permitted in terms of the “Laws of the Sport of Bowls” but these must be completed before the official starting time for play.

### **INCLEMENT WEATHER:**

The Controlling Body reserves the right to alter the conditions of play in the event of inclement weather.

In any circumstances a result shall be declared if 60% of the game has been completed.

## CONDITIONS OF PLAY

### Men's & Women's Under 18

This event will be played under the Laws of the Sport of Bowls, Crystal Mark Edition published September 2006.

Conditions of entry: Players must be 18 years and under for the duration of the event, two (2) male players, two (2) female players.

Format: Singles: 4 Bowls per player, two sets of nine ends, with a tie-breaker if required (with two trial ends).  
Pairs: 2 Bowls per player, two sets of nine ends, with a tie-breaker if required (with two trial ends).

The winner of a set will be the player or team with the highest number of shots when the ninth end is completed. All nine ends of a set should be completed

Format of play: Each side will play 4 tests, each Test will consist of two rounds:  
Round 1 will be four games of singles (two boys and two girls)  
Round 2; two games of pairs (one boys and one girls).

Play will continue over two days with two tests being played on one day. There will be no time limit. Managers will toss to decide which side will play first in each test.

Scoring:

- i) Points shall be awarded as follows:
  - ∴ Two game points will be awarded for each game won. No game points are awarded for any game lost.
  - ∴ One set point will be awarded for each set won. A half set point will be awarded for each set drawn. No set points are awarded for any set lost. (the tie-breaker is not a set)
  
- ii) Test winner will be decided as follows:
  - ∴ Highest number of game points scored.
  - ∴ If game points are equal, the country with the highest number of sets won will be the winner.
  - ∴ If the game points and sets won are equal, the country with the highest margin of set points over all games will be the winner
  - ∴ If game points, sets won and highest margin over all games are equal, the country with the highest net shots will be the winner.

Stamp on bowls:

All bowls used during the event must carry a current World Bowls stamp of 07 or later. Checking of bowls may occur prior to the commencement of games.

## Restriction on movement of players during play:

After delivering their first bowl, players will only be allowed to walk up to the head under the following circumstances.

- Singles game
  - the opponents: after delivery of their third and fourth bowls.
- Pairs game (each player playing two bowls)
  - the leads: after delivery of their second bowl; and
  - the skips: after delivery of their first bowl.

In exceptional and limited circumstances, a skip can ask that a player walks up to the head earlier than described above. If a player does not meet the terms of this law, law 35 will apply.

## Alternation to the format and length of game:

- a. The Controlling Body reserves the right to alter the format, times of play and greens to suit local unforeseen circumstances, giving as much notice as practical.
- b. Where a program is interrupted or cannot be completed due to inclement weather or local conditions, the Jury of Appeal may amend the format and length of games to achieve a result or postpone the event where an outcome cannot be achieved.
- c. Any point not provided for in the rules and Conditions of Play will be decided by the Jury of Appeal

## Substitutes/Replacements:

The Controlling Body shall allow a Substitute or Replacement (providing they are 18 years of age or under) at any stage of the competition on account of illness or other reasonable cause. The Manager of the side affected may call upon a player from their National Authority or may request the host country to provide a replacement or substitute. If there is a possibility of the player returning to play then the new player is classed as a substitute and cannot play in the singles competition. If there is no possibility of the original player returning to competition the new player is a replacement and may play in any position.

## Coaching Staff:

Both countries are able to appoint coaching staff, two (2) from Australia and two (2) from New Zealand. These persons shall be identified to the Chief Umpire and Tournament Director before the start of play. Appointed coaches are the only ones to give advice from beyond the limits of the rink of play.
